Tool overview: TheirStory

TheirStory is a purpose-built application and dedicated online space specifically for facilitating, archiving, and making accessible meaningful conversations now, and for future generations. As an example, TheirStory enables individuals to generate questions that can be used to elicit audiovisual stories both in a multi-person video call as well as to create campaigns for eliciting stories from many individuals asynchronously. When it comes to collection, preservation, access & discoverability, and private/public use of materials, TheirStory is guided by oral history experts to ensure that the platform is grounded in ethical practices.
